Allergies

Please could we ask that you keep us updated with any food allergies or intolerances that your child has. Head Lice

There have been several cases of head lice reported recently. If your child has long hair, please could we ask that this is tied up for school, as this helps prevent them from spreading, thank you.

Jewellery

We have seen several children coming to school with jewellery on, and saying they cannot take their earrings out for PE. A reminder that our uniform policy states;- Children should not have any jewellery on in school. If they have pierced ears, they can wear **plain silver or gold studs** in the bottom of their earlobes. Please can we also advise you to take the studs out on your child's PE days, as they have to be removed to take part in PE. If your child has recently had their ears pierced, they will need to cover them up with tape.
