PSHE

The focus for this half term will be identifying our strengths and skills. We will learn how to set goals for ourselves and how to cope with setbacks.

English

In our English lessons, we will explore the story 'The Treasures of the Loch Ness Monster'. We will explore the beautiful illustrations within the text inferring the characters thoughts and feelings, before writing our own version of it. After this, we will move into non-fiction writing creating a newspaper report based on a sighting of the Loch Ness monster.
