

Literacy

In our literacy lessons, the children will continue looking at different genres of writing and focusing on the grammatical features. To begin with, we will be looking at descriptions, writing the opening to a story, writing a play script and looking at editing and redrafting our work.

It is really important that at home, the children are reading their home readers daily and reading for pleasure which could be magazines, books, comics or non-fiction books. This will have a positive impact on their writing and understanding with their reading.

Spelling tests will be every **Monday**, the children will have their log ins for spelling frame sent home which will help them in their learning. Please practise the spellings with your children as this has a huge impact on their writing.

PE

On Tuesdays, Year 5 will be attending swimming lessons so will need their swimming kit in school.

The whole class will have a PE session on Wednesday afternoon. Full PE kits should be worn all day on this day. That includes the red PE t-shirt, black shorts and jogging bottoms, school jumper and pumps

Art

In art, we will be looking at creating a Mayan headdress which links in with our History topic. We will be practising our sewing skills to then use these in creating our own headdresses.

We will be looking at Balinese music.



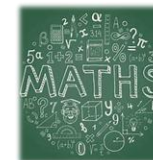
History
