## Welcome

Welcome back.
We have a very busy half term ahead!

Our topic for the next half term will be Oh I do like to be beside the seaside.

We will be looking at People Who Help Us and reading Ten Little Pirates, Rainbow Fish and Starting School. We will also be looking at the characters and how to retell the stories in our own words.

In maths we will be concentrating on numbers 1- 10 and understanding the concept of addition and subtraction practically, counting back from a given number, sequencing events and measurement.

In phonics we will be continuing with Phase 1 with the children. We are concentrating on rhyme and alliteration eg I spy an object that begins with s. snake (hearing that first phoneme.)

Reading is extremely important and lots of stories read to your child is vital. Please read daily to your child and encourage them to join in and talk about the pictures.

Don't forget to look on dojo as this will be our main way to communicate with you. We will show you some of the exciting things we have been up to and how you can further help your child at home.

## P.E every Thursday afternoon. Please come to nursery in appropriate clothing for P.E.

This will be a red t-shirt, black joggers or shorts and black trainers or pumps.
