Summer 2 Nursery Home Learning

Communication & Language

Go outside and play games such as 'I Spy' and 'I Hear'.

Go outside and look at the different things you can see. Have the leaves changed colour? What flowers can you see? What colours can you see?

Talk to your child about your job you do. Explain what you do. Why is your job important?

Literacy

Read the rainbow fish. Talk about what happens in the story. How does the rainbow fish feel?

Discuss starting school. Talk to your child about the transitions they have going on to school every Wednesday. What have they enjoyed? What scared them? What made them happy?

Oh I do like to be beside the seaside

Writing-

Practise writing/mark making your name in some mud or sand.

Can you form your letters correctly in your name?

Maths-

Can you collect objects and put them into two piles? How many do you have altogether? If you take two away how many are you left with?

Can you touch count carefully objects to 10?

Have a go at recognising your numbers to 10. Draw a hop scotch outside and hop on each number and say the numbers out loud.

Go on a number hunt to 10 inside or outside. Can you find numbers to 10 and recognise them all.

Do you know the days of the week? Clap the days of the week as you say them out loud.

<u>Phonics</u> Listening – listen to some music at home, can you clap along with the beat.

Syllables – Encourage the children to clap their name in syllables. Can they clap their brothers, sisters, friend's names in syllables?

Expressive Art and Design

Think about textures. Can you create a picture of the Rainbow Fish? Can you be creative and think about different textures and colours the rainbow fish is.
