Geography:

This half-term will be learning about the UK. We will learn the names and capital cities of the constituent countries that make up our United Kingdom as well as the seas that surround us. English:

This half-term we will be looking at the story of Beauty and the Beast. We will begin by describing different characters and story settings before moving onto creating an innovated version of the story.

Religious Education:

This half-term our focus is on Christian baptism and how this helps people belong to the Church.

Computing:

This half-term we will be learning about coding. We will learn about new functions we can add to our programs such as timers, buttons and collision events!

Music:

This half-term we will be exploring football chants! Lots of repeating patterns to help us develop our own melodies on the glockenspiels.

DT:
