Reading books

Spellings

English:

Our main text this half term is Beauty and the Beast. We will identify and describe characters within the text and write character descriptions. We will sequence the main events within the story and write setting descriptions. Our writing stamina has increased so we will have one last push to remember capital letters at the start of every new sentence and full stops!

Geography:

In Geography we will be learning about the countries that make up the United Kingdom. We will be locating their capital cities and matching the flags to each country. We will locate and name the seas that surround the UK before moving onto learning the names of the oceans and continents in the world.

Mathematics:

We will learn all about the composition of numbers to twenty. We will learn to partition them into tens and ones and learn number bonds to twenty! We will also learn about counting in twos, fives and tens.

Our PE day will continue to be on a <u>Wednesday</u>. This half term it will be athletics where we learn the skills we will need for our sports day activities.
