MATHS

This half-term all pupils will begin looking at numbers 10 - 100. We will explore place value and then how we can use our place value knowledge to help up solve addition and subtraction questions.

ENGLISH

This half-term we will be looking at the story 'After the Fall' which is linked to the nursery rhyme 'Humpty Dumpty'. For this unit of work, our writing focus will be developing the skills to learn and embed finger spaces, capital letters and full stops.

COMPUTING

This half-term we will be learning how to use Purple Mash and Seesaw. We will learn how to stay safe online and about different technology inside and outside of school..

SCIENCE

In Science our topic is 'Animals including humans'. Our topic question is 'Is a human an animal?'. To find out this answer we will be looking at the 5 human senses, sorting animals into groups, looking at animal and human features, what animals eat and looking at what both humans and animals needs to survive.

HAZEL

ART

In art we will be studying how we can use printing to create a piece of artwork. Our artist like will be Vincent Van Gogh with a particular focus on his masterpiece 'Starry Night'. Children will be learning and practicing different ways to print before creating their very own piece of artwork based on 'Starry Night'.

RE

This half-term we are learning about Christianity. Our key question will look at whether how we treat our world matters. We will look at the story of creation and specifically find out how some Christian charities take care of our world. We will also look at what harvest festival is.

MUSIC

We will learn to use our voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes. The music focus will be on beat, rhythm and melody.

HISTORY

This half-term our topic will be the Great Fire of London. We will be exploring the key events that happened, looking at how we know about the GFoL and what changes were made due to the impact of the fire.
