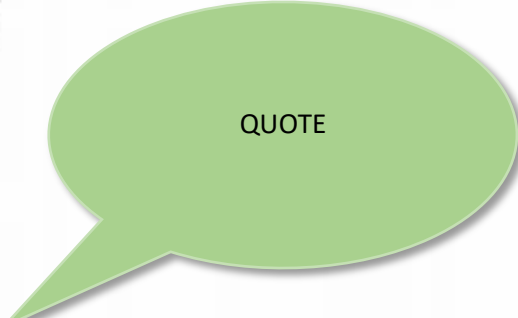
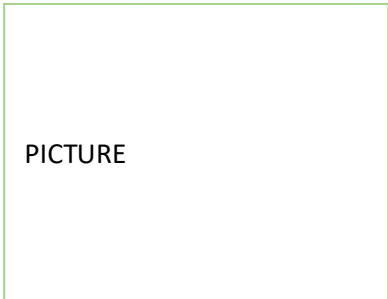




The Roebuck School's RE vision
